INVOCATION


- M: The grace of our Lord (+) Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.


THE WORD

FIRST LESSON

Acts 2:14a, 36-47 The Holy Spirit uses God's Word to create faith

¹⁴ Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and spoke loudly and clearly to them...³⁶ "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." ³⁷ Now when the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Gentlemen, brothers, what should we do?" ³⁸ Peter answered them, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹ For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far away, as many as the Lord our God will call." ⁴⁰ He testified solemnly with many other words and was appealing to them, saying, "Save yourselves from this crooked generation." ⁴¹Those who accepted his message were baptized, and that day about three thousand people were added. ⁴² They continued to hold firmly to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of the bread, and to the prayers. ⁴³ Awe came over every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. ⁴⁴ All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ They were selling their possessions and property and were distributing the proceeds according to what anyone needed. ⁴⁶ Day after day, with one mind, they were devoted to meeting in the temple area, as they continued to break bread in their homes. They shared their food with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ as they continued praising God and being viewed favorably by all the people. Day after day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.

2 Timothy 3:14-16


Continue growing in what you have learned






GOSPEL

And he prunes every branch that does bear fruit, so that it will bear more fruit. ³ "You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. ⁴ Remain in me, and I am going to remain in you. A branch cannot bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Likewise, you cannot bear fruit unless you remain in me. ⁵ "I am the Vine; you are the branches. The one who remains in me and I in him is the one who bears much fruit, because without me you can do nothing. ⁶ If anyone does not remain in me, he is thrown away like a branch and withers. THE PASCHAL CANDLE, the large candle standing beside the altar (and later, the baptismal font), symbolizes the living presence of Christ. 'Paschal' [pronounced: pa-skel] has to do with Passover, that event in the history of Israel when God spared the lives of those who spread the blood of a perfect lamb over the doorframes of their houses. (Exodus 14:1-30) The Bible calls Jesus our 'Passover Lamb,' slain for us. (1 Corinthians 5:7)

On the Paschal Candle are a variety of symbols: A depiction of Jesus as the Sacrificial Lamb of God; a cross, the means by which we are saved through our baptisms; and two Greek letters, an Alpha [A] and an Omega $[\Omega]$, which remind that Jesus is the Beginning and the End. Most importantly, the Paschal Candle symbolizes the resurrection victory over the darkness of sin and death. It is lit during the Easter season and whenever there is a baptism (or funeral), serving as a visual reminder of the close connection between Jesus' resurrection and the new life he gives us at baptism.
